<p>Introduction/ Opening</p>	<p>Show the children the front cover illustration, without the title.</p> <p>Who might these characters be? What makes you think that?</p> <p>What do you think these characters might be like? Why?</p> <p>Add in the title and author.</p> <p>Does the title give us any more clues? What? Why?</p> <p>Show the warning page.</p> <p>What do we mean by a threat?</p> <p>What do you think the threat might be?</p> <p>Does the image give us a clue?</p> <p>Read the first sentence ‘In six days time there will be no more chocolate in the world...ever!’</p> <p>Gauge and discuss children’s responses.</p> <p>What would you do? Why?</p> <p>Continue to read to the end of the Chapter 1 (page 10).</p>
<p>Input</p>	<p>Ask the children to consider how they would feel about the possible chocopocalypse.</p> <p>On a scale of 1 – 10 how bad would it be?</p> <p>Show the children Activity 1 on the board.</p> <p>Discuss the children’s ideas of how they might feel and collect these on the board.</p> <p>Organise by scale of severity.</p> <p>Model how to complete the activity by adding in one or two words.</p>
<p>Independent Activity</p>	<p>Provide children with individual copies of Activity 1 to complete.</p> <p>Extend activity by introducing a thesaurus for children to use to develop and extend vocabulary.</p> <p>Simplify by providing the accompanying word bank (Resource 2) for the children to select appropriate and suitable vocabulary from.</p>
<p>Reflection</p>	<p>Ask the children to share some of their ideas by contributing their most effective descriptive word/phrase.</p> <p>Discuss any variations between responses.</p> <p>Can you think of anything worse than a chocopocalypse?</p>
