<p><b>Introduction/ Opening</b></p>	<p>Revise plans and introduction and headline drafted yesterday. Explain to the class that today they are going to write the first main paragraph of their newspaper report.</p>
<p><b>Input</b></p>	<p>Model the paragraph writing on the IWB together, seeking ideas from the children.</p>
<p><b>Independent Activity</b></p>	<p>Children are to write the first main paragraph for their newspaper report using their planning sheets.</p>
<p><b>Reflection</b></p>	<p>Share and discuss some of the children's work.</p> <p>What problems did you encounter? How did you overcome these problems? Is there anything you would add or improve?</p>
